PROCUREMENT, NEGOTIATION, AND TRANSITION ASSISTANCE

California Community: Cotati, Lincoln, Los Altos, Hemet, Novato, Oakland, Petaluma, and San Fernando

Mr. Pinter assisted jurisdictions in the transition to franchised solid waste operations by performing route audits and assessing the financial impact of newly implemented collection rates. This involved a comparative analysis of new and past program options, as well as a comprehensive survey of the City's commercial solid waste accounts. He has also provided technical assistance with the evaluation of proposals for franchised solid waste, recycling, and disposal operations, as well as developing cost evaluation models to assist in summarizing proposed customer rates.

SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING MARKET SURVEYS

Mr. Pinter has conducted solid waste and recycling market surveys which have involved telephone interviews, internet research and compiling acquired data into charts and tables for comparative analysis.
